# University of Bearly Quilting Class Schedule

## Machine Embroidery Club:

This club is geared to just having fun! There is no supply list, nothing to buy, no pattern to follow, and no teacher to listen to. Just bring your embroidery machine, necessary tools, gadgets, and whatnots to create the day away with friends. The group usually meets on the first Monday of every month from 10:30-2:30pm (*call or check our calendar for any changes to the schedule*). \$5 fee each month.

## Wild Rose Block-of-the-Month ...*designed by: Marti Michell*

Marti has really outdone herself this time! Classically simple, here her lovely old fashioned roses meet cherry blossoms and charming foliage for a collection that's homey yet elegant - and just downright pretty! Use the white colorway for a subtle, light and airy look, or choose black for a fantastic punch of drama. Lots of mini florals, plus coordinates from 'Wild Rose Basics' complete the grouping for Marti's gorgeous new Block-of-the-Month, 'American Beauty', which she designed especially for this collection. Choose from finishing with Black rose setting triangles and borders or white rose setting triangles and borders. Finished size is 84" x 104". This class is intended for the intermediate level quilter and above.

Classes will be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday or the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month starting in January.

Cost is \$22.00 per month for pattern and fabric.

## "A Vintage Christmas" Block-of-the-Month:

Decorate your home in vintage style with "A Vintage Christmas". The applique is fun and the look is soft and vintage. Hang "A Vintage Christmas" on your wall and fill the room with glitter houses, vintage sheep, and vintage ornaments for the perfect vintage look! The finished quilt measures 55" x 53".

This is a 10-month program with classes usually held on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of each month starting in February. This class is intended for the intermediate level quilter and above.

Cost is \$35 for month 1 and \$25 per month for months 2-10.

## "Bag Lady" Class: ...*with Cheryl Guhl*

Are you tired of the same old bag? Want a new look? What about a hip new tote? Then this might be what you need! Bring yourself, a friend, or come down and meet new ones at these fun and exciting classes. The quilt is machine pieced with fusible applique details. The quilt measures 70" x 70" finished. This will be a 6-month program with classes held on the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday or 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month starting in April.

## ABCs of Log Cabin: *...with the Bearly Quilting Staff*

Are you ready to go beyond beginning quilting? Learn the techniques of making traditional log cabin quilts using Marti Mitchells' methods and ruler. Follow along in her book while using her ruler and learn that a log cabin quilt can be as easy as "ABC". This is a 2-week course with classes held on consecutive Friday evenings according to the following schedule.

This will be a fun four weeks of classes packed with several techniques from Eleanor Burns' book *"It's El'ementary"*. You will learn new techniques from pieced blocks to appliqué and will end up with a beautiful sampler quilt. The finished quilt will be 45x45 square. This is a 4-week course with classes held each Saturday according to the following schedule.

## Intermediate Machine Quilting: ...with Jill Schumacher

Jill Schumacher will be back to teach another 1-day "Intermediate Machine Quilting" workshop. This class is for those who have explored beginning machine quilting, but would like to learn more. This class is geared toward the quilter who can do simple machine quilting basics, but wants to learn more elaborate designs and how to stitch them. The class is taught using your home sewing machine. You will learn to quilt beautiful feather designs, borders, and adding decorative background quilting designs. You will have a miniature whole cloth quilt suitable for a wall hanging or to be made into a designer pillow when you complete your project.

Cost: \$50

Class: Monday, April 26<sup>th</sup> from 10:30-4:30pm

## Transitions: ...with Carole Juergenson

This contemporary quilt design is a great way to use your favorite batiks or traditional blender fabrics in a way to show off color "transitions". Using the strip-piece technique and a commercial pattern, we will explore the on-point setting and color.

Cost: \$45

Class: Saturday, May 1<sup>st</sup> from 10-4pm

## Crazy 9 Patch: ...with Chris Zeterberg

Let's go totally crazy. The Crazy 9-Patch will be the craziest quilt that you make...and you'll love it! You'll want to do it over and over again. It's that easy and fun too. I should know, I've done a bunch of them and still love to make them. Even if you use the same fabric, the quilt will still look different the second time around. Now that's what I call crazy.

Cost: \$25

Class: Friday, April 9<sup>th</sup> from 10:30-3:30pm

## Perfect Binding Class: ...with Nancy Zeterberg

You are now entering the Perfect Binding zone. Your bindings will look perfect with this technique. Nancy will teach you how to make the perfect mitered corners, front and back, for your quilt. Even the judges at the quilt shows will be impressed because the mitered corners will be perfect! So come and enjoy a day of making the "Perfect Binding".

Dots are in and this quilt is a fun way to show them off. The "open boxes" are Y-seams made easy and the pieced border is fun and quick. If dots are not your thing, other fabric will work just as well and create a new look.
